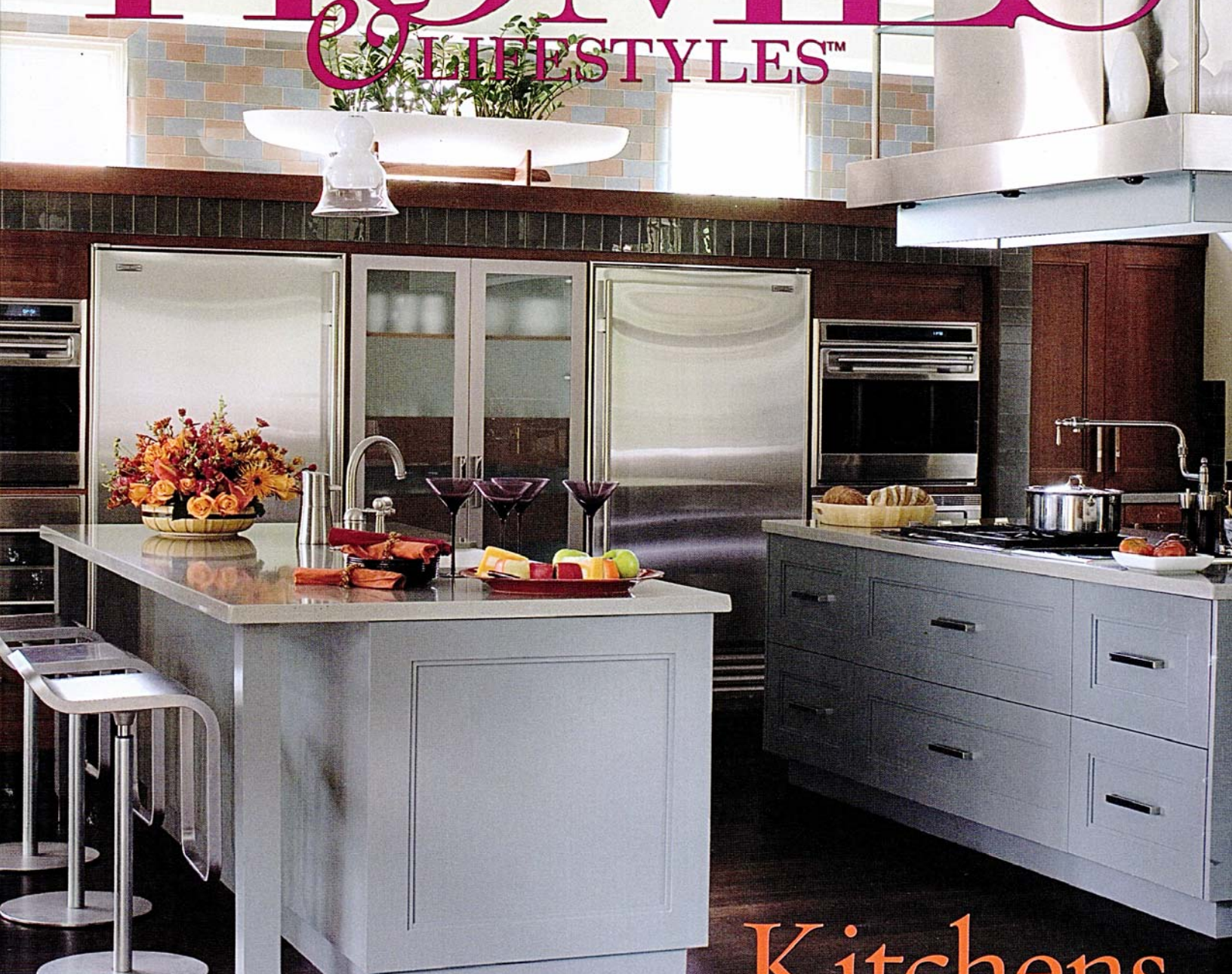

This rustic, woodsy kitchen was inspired by the homeowners' European travels. Charged with creating an "Italian Country" kitchen, designer Peter Wycoff masterfully blended an earthy palette of wood, stone and metal with all the necessary modern conveniences. "The Colorado rocks that frame the stove and entrance to the pantry were put in with a labor of love," remembers Wycoff of the difficult installation. The custom cabinets are designed to fill quirky spaces reminiscent of an old Italian kitchen.
